- Association Participation in “Dobro.Ru” Festival in Samara:

°Yevgheniy Yamburg’s master-class

On February 16<sup>th</sup> the Samara Universal Science Library welcomed a master-class by an Honored Teacher of the Russian Federation, Associate member of the Russian Academy of Education, Yevgheniy A.Yamburg, PhD. The seminar was on the topic of “Strategy and Tactics of Modern Education”.



The participants of the master-class were 70 directors and teachers of the city of Samara and the Samara Region, as well as college students preparing to become teachers, representatives of NGOs, and volunteers.

During the master-class they discussed tendencies of the development of the system of education, existing and possible problems as well as solutions for them. Yevgheniy Yamburg also showed footage of lessons in his school and celebrations in the Center of Education #109 where Yevgheniy Yamburg is a director. Professor also answered questions that the teachers and heads of educational institutions had for him.

As a gift to the participants, the Let’s Give Children All We’ve Got! Association gave out 100 “School and its Surroundings” books by Yevgheniy Yamburg.

The class lasted for 4 hours.

As a result, many participants showed interest in becoming members of the Association.



Responses and impressions of the master-class participants:

*I am thrilled. He talks about problems in the world, in the country, and in the teaching community in such an emotional and captivating way. But most importantly, he not only raises questions and describes problems – he suggests ways of solving them without pushing his own opinion. He says, “I did it like that, and if you are smart – do it in a different way, do it better than me!” And this to me was most important. It’s interesting that only a person that is truly free inside can look for such or similar solutions that our country, our society, and our teaching community are currently facing.*

*This is the third time that I came to hear Yevgheniy Alexandrovich. As a result of grant contest that had been held in September 1<sup>st</sup> through November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013, the winners were declared:

### Teacher Grants:

- 1) Marina Tyrtysnaya (Yoshkar-Ola, Lyceum Baumansky), Kind City Project. A Grant of 839,000 rubles.
- 2) Vladimir Chikishev (Nizhniy Novgorod, Boarding School for Deaf Children, Children's Piano Theatre), Bridge into Silence Project. Grant of 525,000 rubles.
- 3) Sergey Akulinin (Omsk, «Constellation» Municipal Institution for Additional Education of Children), Oleg Mityaev's D-Plus Studio project. A Grant of 300,000 rubles.

In 2013 the municipal institutions that had applied for grants and won them opened Let's Give Children All We've Got! Association Branches where educational programs based on the Bright Future Studio model are currently being realized.

**On April 13** the Let’s Give Children All We’ve Got! Association delegation came to Yoshkar-Ola, the capital of the Republic of Mariy El.

**Yevgheniy Alexandrovich Yamburg**, a renowned teacher, an academic bearing the title of an Honored Teacher of Russia held a “Strategy and Development of Education” seminar in the **Mariy State University** that gathered representatives of the Ministry of Education, 90 school principals, 111 vice-principles, 139 students, assistant professors and masters, 73 teachers, 11 heads and specialists of the departments of education, as well as 21 methodologists and psychologists – **445 representatives of the system of education** from the Republic – which is home to only 250,000 people. Master-class lasted for **6 hours** which was too short, according to the attendees’ comments.



Teachers and students had an opportunity not only to hear the renowned educator, but to ask him questions and to get an autograph in his “School and its Surroundings” book. 100 books by Y.A.Yamburg were given out as gifts to the most active participants of the master-class.





At the same time as Yamburg's master-class was held, the teacher of the Chelyabinsk Bright Future Studio **Jesse Mara**, and director of special projects for the Let's Give Children All We've Got! Association and Studio director **Anna Mara** held a meeting with **the students and teachers of the Kind City Studio** – the Association Branch. The Studio opened in



February 2013 in the Lyceum Baumansky that for many years has been directed by **Grigoriy Yefimovich Peisakhovich** – it's a real Center of Education where education, sports, art, and even medical treatment become segments of the same process that is center around a child.

The children basically live in their school, and they always have wise and interesting teachers next to them. **Marina Alexeyevna Tyrtysnaya**, the Kind City Studio director and the Lyceum vice-director – took the Chelyabinsk delegation on an excursion around the Lyceum.

The Kind City Studio is for those of the Lyceum students whose life situations leave much to be desired.

**The Association grant that the Lyceum had won** allowed them to begin implementing additional

programs for those children who are physically challenged and even helped some of them to open the door to a new life – a life outside the four walls of their home.

At the open lesson with Jesse and Anna 25 students and their teachers learned to sing an English song, to say a few words in Spanish, and even said the word "Friendship" in sign language.

The meeting with **30 heads of institutions of additional education** and representatives of non-governmental organizations of the Republic of Mariy El began with the show of "Everything We Do" documentary about the work of the Studio in Chelyabinsk by Sergey Miroschnichenko's "Ostrov" Studio (directed by Angelina Golikova). Touching stories of the children, the enthusiasm of the teachers, sincere optimistic interviews with the National Artist of Russia Oleg Mityaev, as well as inspiring stories of the benefactor Anthony Melikhov caused great interest, and at the press-conference right after the



showing anyone who wished could ask Anna and Jesse questions, since were shown in the documentary as well. The audience asked about fundraising possibilities during this challenging for additional education time, about possibilities for volunteers to participate in similar projects, and about adapting the models of the Chelyabinsk and

Yoshkar-Ola Studios for other regions.

The Chelyabinsk guests also spent a few hours in the **famous Yamburg School** in Moscow, where they met the teachers, students, and parents of the Center of Education #109. **Yevgheniy Alexandrovich Yamburg** and his vice-director of training programs **Olga Sergeyevna Vertelina**, and well as the vice-director of arts program **Yevgheniy Alexandrovich Nikishin** took the delegation on 2 excursions around all the buildings of the Center, told of their methods of teaching, and introduced to their best teachers.





**Analytical Note from Oleg Mityaev's Bright Future Studio Director in Chelyabinsk,  
director of Special Projects for the Association Anna Mara**

I consider the trip successful. Total number of participants: 550 (counting the volunteers helping with the organization of the seminar and the master-class).

**Suggested improvements:**

1. To do similar events in two days instead of one so that those teachers who want to come for both the seminar and Yamburg's master-class can do that – as is, they have to choose between the two.
2. To include into the program a concert/meeting with a performer who is a friend of the Association – a person bearing our ideology, in order to enrich the cultural background of the teachers, to attract additional interest to the event, as well as to create an emotional atmosphere that will contribute to active participation. This could be Mityaev, Ivashchenko, Khomchik, etc.
3. Where possible, to bring the choir of the Chelyabinsk Studio – direct proof of the success of our work.

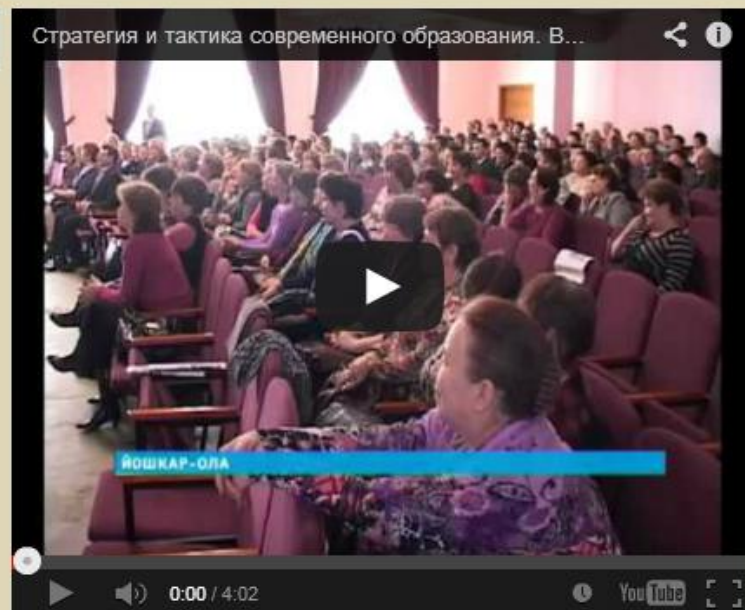

The Studio opened on March 1, 2012, in the “Strannik” Hikers’ Club, a municipal institution of additional education, where 50 students at the age of 8 to 14 study local history, hiking, scouting, and English.

The children that go for classes in the Bright Future Studio have at one time found themselves in difficult circumstances, most of them come from underprivileged families: those whose income doesn’t exceed the subsistent level that had been set at 5,552 rubles, families with lots of children, families with handicapped children or handicapped parents; foster families, families where one of the parents is serving time in jail, and so on.

On the other hand, these are the children who want to learn something new, find new friends, and test their skills in hikes and trips, as well as become useful members of their family and society at large.

At the open class with Jesse and Anna Mara 50 students and 4 of the Studio teachers learned an English song, a few phrases in Spanish, and the word “Friendship” in sign language.

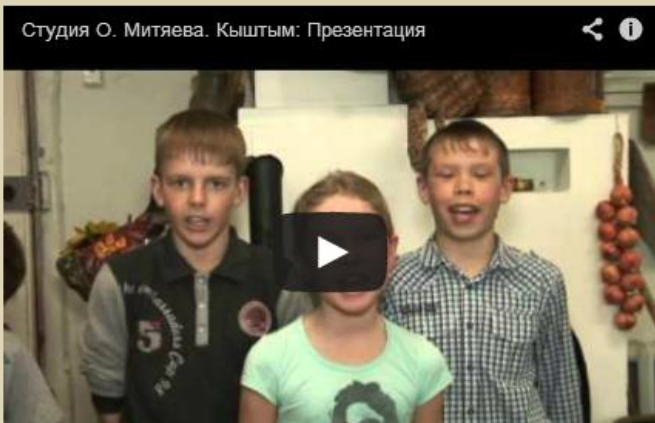

The Excursion around the festival grounds called "Walking through the Emerald City" was hosted by **Larissa P. Korobizina** – the founder of the Ilmensky Festival.

At the "Campfire of new friends" the Forum participants shared their joys and hopes with the Forum organizers – Oleg Mityaev's Foundation Chairman **Yelena Grishina**, Bright Future International President **Anthony Melikhov**, and Association director **Anna Mara**.

The next day of the Forum started with the Round Table discussion called "**Walking the Path of Kindness**". **Stage 3:** Holding simultaneous social events with the participation of the LGCAWG members and their students, as well as other active members of the society with the media highlighting the event (the media should be attracted by the video presentations, press-releases done in the same format for all participants, and by internet-teasers).

**Stage 4:** Event presentation in the form of a live webcast under the name of "One Day of the Association in Facts and Numbers", where the results of the events will be heard by everyone (it is suggested to include the airing of the news pieces done by the local media or by the participants themselves).

- Note: while planning the event it is suggested to consider local needs and including famous people that come from the given region. Forum participants shared their ideas and experience they already have from holding similar events.





## Dates:

**July 15** – all event participants send in the briefs of their events (format, idea, participants, etc.)

**October 15** – trial live webcast with all participants. Until then they set up the equipment necessary for the webcast locally.

**December 3** – DATE THE EVENTS WILL BE HELD, with participation of local media

**December 10** – online discussion – a live webcast which will include all the participating cities, and videos from the media

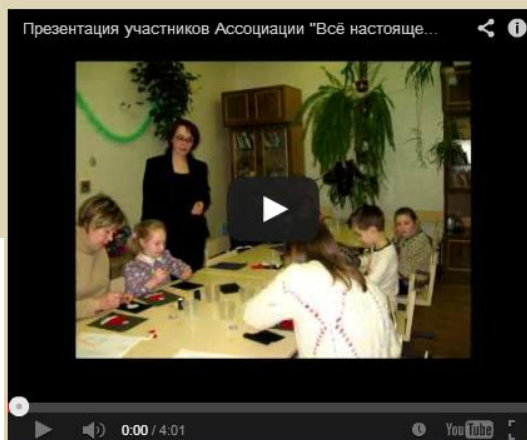

3. Among Association members more than 50% are heads of subjects (Centers of Additional Education, children's media, children's festivals, ecology gallery ...)

### VALUE OF ASSOCIATION AS A NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION

1. Personal membership (questionnaire based enlistment) lets us avoid formal approach and create a union of active specialists and caring people, based on the results of their work with the children;
2. charity based activity of Association members, positive approach to life, a readiness to change themselves and change the world (personal communications with Association members, retreats in Branch cities, news on the LGCAWG site);
3. a desire and interest for uniting as the potential for developing a "network" and LGCAWG program:

## ASSOCIATION DEVELOPMENT SUGGESTIONS FOR 2014:

1. Development of the site that reflects the geographical status of the Association;
2. communications (virtual) of teachers and **children**, who are included in the program;  
***Preliminary title – “Republic of the Future” social group or network, and later communications of the participants at the Ilmensky Festival where the real (not virtual) Republic of the Future works;***
3. stimulate active participation of Association members:
  - holding a simultaneous fundraising event (December of 2013);
  - grants for 2014 that will consider how active a member has been in the Association work;
  - \* grants for 2013 work effectively judging by the current reports of Branches (see site);**
4. «Retreats in Branches» need to be held regularly and in a fuller capacity, with invited artists (as discussed earlier).

### Plans. Point 1:

#### Association participation in the V-th “Summer is a Life in Itself” festival of song in Sochi



The Festival will be held **on August 23–25 in Sochi.**

Festival organizers – **Sochi Administration and Oleg Mityaev’s Foundation.** General partner of the Festival – **Bright Future International.**

**Special guests of the festival** – children and teachers from Chelyabinsk (Oleg Mityaev’s Bright Future Studio), from Nizhniy Novgorod (Piano Theatre), and Yoshkar-Ola (Kind City Studio) – who will all perform on the Festival stage alongside famous artists. They will also study in **“Mikhail Kazinik’s School”**, and attend many workshops. This program will be realized within the framework of the **Let’s Give Children All We’ve Got! Association program.**





## Plans. Point 2:

### Preparation for and conducting the International event of the Association (December 2013).

At present we're collecting short descriptions of local events that are being made by the Association participants according to specific interests and demands of their clubs and area.

#### Example: Local Event Description from Snezhinsk:

*Dear Friends,*

*Do you remember how when you were a kid you always looked forward to your birthday? You had so many birthday wishes! And the most important one was always supposed to come true right on your birthday.*

*And on that day you were expecting a pile of presents, entertainment, surprised, and of course, many guests and close friends!*

*As you grow up you start to realize that there is nothing impossible. And giving a child a party that HE or SHE really expects, is not that complicated.*

*A group of adults and children from the Palace of Art for Children and Youth of Snezhinsk will create a day long party for the children that need it the most.*

*On December 3, 2013, the Tyubuk Orphanage of Kaslinsky District of the Chelyabinsk region will welcome a "Family Birthday" party: a concert, contests, games, and a handcrafts workshop, sending party mail and serving treats. All of this will come from children to children!!!*

#### Local Event Description from Yoshkar-Ola:

*A Vaccine from old age*

*Organizing Committee: older kids from the Kind City Studio (25-30 children)*

*Participants: Lyceum Baumansky students – 100 people, as well as the teachers and the administration of the Lyceum.*

*The event will be held for pensioners and senior citizens (we plan 70 to 100 people)*

*What will be organized: a concert, meetings with celebrities, more than 20 master-classes (about health, handcrafts, computer knowledge and so on, that will help older people adapt to the modern world conditions, to bring joy by teaching new skills and allowing a platform for communication.*
